8. Elevator pitch:

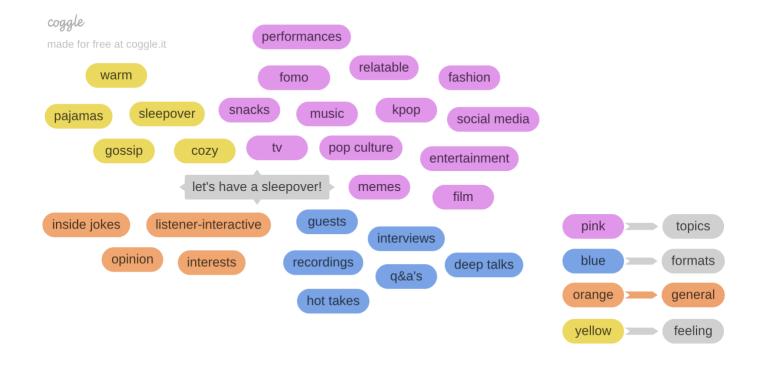
Like chatting with your older sister, Nessa goes on about FOMO, music and fashion today, and questionable hot takes.

## **MESSAGE/STORY:**

- 1. What message are you trying to deliver to the audience?

- **b.** Middle: Get into today's pop culture scene, personal opinions/hot takes, describe life currently.
- **c.** End: Reflecting on the episode + wrapping everything up. End saying FOMO is normal, we all experience it, and to live life!

## **NARRATION/HOST:**

- 1. Who will lead us through the piece?
- 2. Narration ideas: Voiced by me, narration is conversational and has a late-night-talk vibe.
